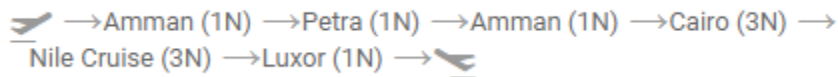


## Leisure & Wellness

### **Day 1: Arrive into Amman - Begin your 'Egypt with Jordan' Tour**

Welcome to Jordan - the Holy Land. On arrival at Queen Alia International Airport, you will be greeted by your friendly tour manager / local representative outside the baggage hall who will take you to your hotel. The rest of the day is free for you.

Overnight at the hotel in Amman.

### **Day 2: Onto Petra - Visit to Madaba, Visit to Mount Nebo & Visit to the Dead Sea**

Today, we check out and proceed to Petra via Madaba the city of Mosaics, which has the oldest known mosaic map of the holy land, after which we will go to view the Jordan Valley from the famous Mount Nebo visiting its Byzantine Church. Then proceed to the Dead sea, which is the lowest point on earth 400 meters below sea level.

Overnight at the hotel in Petra.

### **Day 3: Guided Walking City Tour of Petra, Guided City Tour of Amman**

Today, we check out and proceed on a guided walking city tour of Petra, visiting the rose-red city known as Sela in the Bible and lost to the world for five centuries until it was rediscovered in 1812. Enter Petra on horseback through a narrow gorge carved in the sandstone and opening on the stunning view of the Treasury, made famous in the movie "Indiana Jones and the Temple of Doom". Visit the palace, the High Palaces and the Roman-Style Palace Tomb.

Next, we drive to Amman. On arrival, we proceed on a guided city tour of Amman. See the Archeological Museum, Folklore Museum, the Citadel and the Roman Amphitheatre.

Overnight at the hotel in Amman.

### **Day 4: Fly to Cairo, Sound & Light Show at the Pyramids in Cairo**

Today, we drive to the airport for our flight to Cairo. Welcome to Egypt - the Land of the Pharaohs. On arrival, at Cairo International airport, we transfer you to your hotel for check-in.

Later this evening, experience the spectacular Sound and Light Show at the Giza Pyramids of Khufu, Khafre and Menkaure and enjoy the history of the ancient Egyptians. The show begins with the story of the Sphinx who has been the vigilant guardian of the Pyramids for

five thousand years.

Overnight at the hotel in Cairo.

#### **Day 5: Day Trip to Alexandria with Guided City Tour & Visit to Papyrus Shop**

Today, we proceed on a day trip to Alexandria. On our guided city tour, we first visit Pompey's Pillar - the only known free-standing column in Roman Egypt which was not composed of drums and is one of the largest ancient monoliths ever erected. Next, we make a photo stop at Qaitbay Citadel for a magnificent view of the Mediterranean sea. It was erected on the exact site of the famous Lighthouse of Alexandria, which was one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. After, visiting the Library of Alexandria, we return to Cairo. On arrival, we visit a Papyrus Shop where you will see a demonstration of how Papyrus - a thick paper like material produced from the pith of a papyrus plant found in the Nile delta and usually grown 5 to 9 feet tall.

Overnight at the hotel in Cairo.

#### **Day 6: Guided City Tour of Cairo- Visit to an Egyptian Perfumery, Visit the Egyptian Museum with Royal Mummies Room & Visit Khan El Khalili Bazaar**

Today, we take you on a guided city tour of Cairo. See the Pyramids of Khufu, Khafre and Menkaure. Also see the Sphinx, carved from the natural bedrock at the bottom of the causeway to Khafre's pyramid. Then, we visit an Egyptian Perfumery.

Next, we visit the Egyptian Museum, which houses over 1,00,000 antiquities from every period of ancient Egyptian history. Do not miss the gallery featuring the famous treasures of Tutankhamun. We also visit the Royal Mummies Room, another highlight of the Egyptian Museum. Here you can see the mummies of many great Egyptian rulers, including Ramses II, the builder of the temples at Abu Simbel. Later, proceed to the medieval market of Khan-El-Khalili where you can shop for spices, precious stones and curios.

Overnight at the hotel in Cairo.

#### **Day 7: Fly to Aswan & Welcome Aboard the Nile Cruise**

Today, we check-out of the hotel and drive to the airport for our flight to Aswan. On arrival, we board our legendary Nile Cruise for a great three day journey on the scenic Nile River.

Overnight on board the Nile Cruise.

#### **Day 8: Visit to Abu Simbel, Visit the High Dam & Visit to Temple of Kom Ombo**

Today, after collecting your box breakfast, we proceed to visit Abu Simbel by coach (3.30 am departure for Abu Simbel). Abu Simbel has two magnificent temples, temple of Ramesses II and the Temple of Nefertari. The Temples were threatened by submersion in the Lake Nasser, due to the construction of the High Dam. During the salvage operation which continued until 1968, the two temples were dismantled and raised over 60 meters up on the sandstone cliff where they had been built more than 3,000 years before.

On return to Aswan, we proceed to visit the High Dam of Aswan, the pride of Egypt and an ideal spot for a panoramic view of Aswan. Then, we board our cruise for lunch, as our cruise starts sailing to Kom Ombo. On arrival, we visit the famous Temple of Kom Ombo. Overlooking the Nile, this unique temple is in fact the fusion of two temples, set side by side, with each side having its own gateways and chapels. The left side of the temple is dedicated to Haroeris, the falcon headed God. The right part of the temple is dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile headed God and God of Fertility. Overnight on board the Nile Cruise.

### **Day 9: Visit to Edfu & Sail to Luxor via Esna Lock, Visit to Temple of Luxor**

Today morning, on arrival into Edfu, we take you on a shore excursion to visit the Temple of Edfu. Of all the temples of ancient Egypt, the one at Edfu is not only the best preserved, but the second largest after Karnak. The temple had been totally submerged under the desert except for the very top of the pylon entrance. The temple is dedicated to Horus and was built in the Ptolemaic period. This temple is unusual in that it is on the west bank of the river which was normally dedicated to the afterlife. Next, enjoy the sights of the Nile River from the deck, as your Nile Cruise sails to Luxor via the Esna Lock.

On arrival in Luxor, we visit the famous Temple of Luxor. There is magic in the tombs of the great Kings with their imposing architecture and marvelous paintings. Even after over 5,000 years, the paintings retain their original colors and tell the story of civilization gone by.

Overnight on board the Nile Cruise.

### **Day 10: Visit to Valley of the Kings, Visit to Temple of Hatshepsut & Visit to Karnak Temple**

Today, we check-out from our cruise and visit the West Bank of Luxor. We proceed deep into the desert to discover the Valley of Kings. This is the place where generations of pharaohs and nobles were buried in great splendour, housed in crypts cut into the cliffs. Next, our excursion takes us to explore Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, the only woman Pharaoh to have ruled Egypt. We, then visit the Karnak Temple, known as Ipet-isu—or “most select of places”—by the ancient Egyptians. It is a city of temples built over 2,000 years and is the largest religious building ever made, covering about 200 acres (1.5 km by 0.8 km), and was a place of pilgrimage for nearly 2,000 years. The great temple at the heart of Karnak is so big that St. Peter’s, Milan, and Notre Dame Cathedrals would fit within its walls. The Hypostyle hall, at 54,000 square feet (16,459 meters) and featuring 134 columns, is still the largest room of any religious building in the world.

Later, check into your hotel in Luxor.

### **Day 11: Return home with wonderful memories**

Today, we drive you to the airport for our flight back home. It's time to say goodbye to all the new friends you have made. We hope you take back many happy memories of your holiday.
